DPO: What is it and what does it do?

A DPO (Data Protection Officer) is the person responsible for data protection within a company. This role was created by the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), which took effect in May 2018.

A DPO's responsibilities are diverse and varied: informing and advising management on data protection matters; monitoring compliance with the GDPR; assisting with impact assessments; serving as the point of contact for data subjects and supervisory authorities; and, finally, ensuring data governance.

Failure to comply with the GDPR can have significant consequences, such as heavy financial penalties, loss of trust among customers and partners, or damage to the company's image and reputation.

However, for a microbusiness or small-to-medium-sized enterprise (SME), hiring a DPO is not financially viable, and assigning this role to an internal employee exposes the company to an increased risk of conflicts of interest and time constraints.
